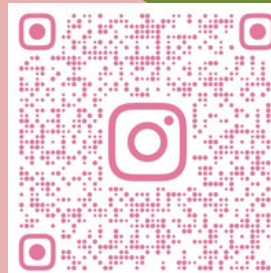
# WHAT I WOULD DO:

**Newman** - Though we all love Newman, we can all agree that there are many changes needed in order to fulfill our needs as students. Newman was supposed to be a building that was constantly evolving with its students, but unfortunately that hasn't been the case. A main goal of mine as College Officer is to update the interior of the building by providing a large increase of seating and tables for students to use. There is a lot of wasted space in Newman with the way they have arranged some of the seating. The maintenance of Newman would also be something that I strive to change. Instead of the temporary fixes they have been using to fix the bathrooms and ceilings, I want to find permanent solutions. By putting in more and better quality seating, students' qualities of both the social and academic aspects in your lives would be improved.

**Sense of Community** - One thing that I have noticed is that as the Arts & Humanities building, there is a huge lack of art and culture in Newman.
